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Admission Criteria

- Individuals must be in their 20s and have a disability.
- Individuals must be able to live independently with supports and not require a supervised or certified living situation.
- Individuals must have the capacity to self-direct supports needed to live independently.
- Individuals must be in reasonably stable health.
- Individuals must not have a history of criminal behavior.
- Individuals who have a psychiatric diagnosis must be under the care of a licensed professional. A current evaluation must indicate that he/she can live safely and independently and that the condition is stable.
- Individuals must fully disclose any use of alcohol and/or other drugs as well as related treatment received for drug or alcohol use. The admissions committee will carefully review this information.
- Individuals must agree to Program Code of Conduct.
- Individuals must be willing and able to work and/or volunteer and/or be involved in education or another similar program.
- Individuals and/or families must have the ability to pay the program fee and other expenses.
- Individuals must have health insurance or enrollment in a government healthcare program and must submit a current medical evaluation stating any physical limitations.
- Individuals must agree to participate in the Philadelphia Independence Network Community.
