Community Homes

Homes are available that provide 24 hours of supervision, ranging in size for one to six people with intellectual disabilities. Each home enhances the individual's interests and abilities, with an emphasis on community involvement, stability, and maintaining important ties to families and loved ones.

Services

- Supports individuals to achieve their full potential and independence
- Maintains and strengthens relationships with friends and families
- Actively supports engagement with the community—providing support for individuals to serve as volunteers; to engage in religious, cultural and social activities; to use public transportation; to patronize local businesses; and to enjoy trips and vacations
- Provides excellent direct support to ensure that the individual remains safe in a family-style home

Eligibility

- Must meet waiver eligibility requirements

Enrollment

- All admissions referred through Mental Retardation Services in Philadelphia, the Montgomery County Office of Mental Retardation, or the Pennsylvania State Office of Developmental Programs

Cost

Fee is based on a review of the individual's income from Social Security and Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
