## In-home Supports and Supported Independent Living

Committed to empowering individuals to make choices, develop new abilities, and cultivate their special talents in their homes and communities.

### Services

- Customized services and supports designed to respond to the needs of the person and the primary caregiver
- Supports to shop, clean, and complete other daily living activities
- Participation in community activities, recreation
- Financial counseling, money management
- Access to medical appointments
- Support individuals in connecting with others in their natural surroundings and/or in integrating into their communities

### Eligibility

- Must be age 18 or older with an intellectual/developmental disability, meeting waiver eligibility requirements
- Supported Independent Living  
Participants must require 30 hours or less of support each week

### Enrollment

- Contact your supports coordinator for a referral
- All admissions referred through Mental Retardation Services in Philadelphia or the Montgomery County Office of Mental Retardation

### Cost

Funding for eligible participants is available through the Pennsylvania State Waiver Program
