## Job Readiness for Refugees and Asylees

Helps refugees, asylees, and victims of trafficking prepare to enter the workforce, find satisfying jobs ranging from labor to professional positions, and become self-sufficient members of society.

### Services

- Vocational English Language Training (VELT) classes
- Acculturation workshops
- Case management services
- Interviewing, résumé writing, workforce foundation skills, and job readiness and retention workshops
- Computer literacy classes
- Job placement assistance and follow-up
- Youth program assisting 16- and 17-year-olds find part-time work during the school year, or full-time summer employment

### Eligibility

- Residents of Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Philadelphia Counties with refugee status and within 5 years of date of entry to the United States, even if a Green Card has been received
- Residents of Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Philadelphia Counties who are granted asylum or victim of trafficking status
- United States citizens are not eligible
