Services

- Job assessment, readiness, and placement assistance for unemployed and underemployed Jewish women through our Working for Success program
- Job assessment, readiness, and placement assistance for unemployed and underemployed Jews under the age of 65 through *helpinghands*
- Internships for Jewish high school and full-time undergraduate college students
- PSAT, SAT, ACT, and SAT Subject Test preparation, high school subject tutoring, and post secondary education plans
- Career guidance for Jewish professionals in transition
- Series of free seminars and support groups related to career development and educational guidance at local synagogues, libraries, and community centers
