

Supports for Independence

Attendant Care Service Coordination

Adults 18 years of age or older who have a disability that will last for over a year may use our Attendant Care Service Coordination to help them stay in their own homes, go to work, attend school, and participate more fully in the community.

Services

- A dedicated Service Coordinator will help individuals create a personalized care plan
- Service Coordinators will provide consumers with on going support, reevaluating service plans and hours of care as needed
- Call Center support to answer questions and provide information about other services available
- In-home visits are scheduled at dates/times of the consumer's choice
- Emergency support is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

Payment agent services

- Must be 18-59 years of age, mentally alert, have a long term disability, and live in Pennsylvania
- Must be enrolled in the Pennsylvania Attendant Care Program
