Offers customized community employment opportunities to individuals with disabilities. The goal is to promote independence in the world of work with assistance from job coaches and natural supports. Candidates are assisted in finding jobs that offer them the greatest potential for success based upon their interests and skills.

Services

- Situational assessments and vocational evaluations
- Career exploration
- Individualized employment counseling
- Individualized job development—assistance with finding and securing competitive employment
- On-the-job training and mentoring from job coaches
- Development of natural supports on the job
- Volunteer opportunities

Eligibility

- Individuals age 18 or older with a physical, intellectual, learning, or psychiatric disability, or chronic condition meeting eligibility requirements of the Pennsylvania Office of Vocational Rehabilitation
- Individuals 18 or older who have an intellectual/developmental disability, meeting waiver eligibility requirements
- Philadelphia County residents, age 18 or older, who have a mental illness and meet Philadelphia County Office of Behavioral Health eligibility requirements
