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Admission Criteria – Fall 2016

- Members must be young adults living with a disability.
- Members must be able to live independently with supports; not requiring a supervised or certified living situation.
- Members must be in reasonably stable health.
- Members must not have a history of criminal behavior.
- Members who have a psychiatric diagnosis must be under the care of a licensed professional. A current evaluation must indicate that he/she can live safely and independently and that the condition is stable.
- Members must fully disclose any use of alcohol and/or other drugs as well as related treatment received for drug or alcohol use. The admissions committee will carefully review this information.
- Members must agree to Program Code of Conduct.
- Members must be willing and able to work and/or volunteer and/or be involved in education or another similar program.
- Members and/or families must pay the program fee and other expenses.
- Members must have health insurance or enrollment in a government healthcare program and must submit a current medical evaluation stating any physical limitations.
- Members must actively participate in the Philadelphia Independence Network community.
