- Philadelphia youth ages 18–24
- No high school diploma
- Meets financial requirements

How is JEVS Project WOW different than other GED® programs in the city?

While the program provides high school equivalency or GED® (General Educational Development) test preparation, students also receive hands-on training

in building trades (property maintenance and repair) or information technology (mobile/computer tech and repair) that prepares students for the world of work.

Our individualized **"Career Pathway"** program structure offers:

HANDS-ON CAREER TRAINING OPTIONS...

in high-demand industries, such as building trades and IT-information technology. If these career areas are not of interest to students, they can elect to participate in individualized career exploration.

PARTICIPATION IN A SERVICE LEARNING PROJECT...

for students who thrive on "learning by doing," while experiencing the rewards of giving back to the community and working as a team. Projects may take place in students' neighborhoods or benefit local organizations or charities in need of a hand.

INCENTIVES...

including a weekly TransPass for getting to and from class, GED® test fees covered, and financial incentives for reaching particular program milestones.

PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM...

Training provides a stepping stone to registered apprenticeship opportunities.

Project WOW's team of committed experts help students succeed during the 23-week program and support them for a year as they begin their new careers.
